The Collaborative provided analytical and mapping services as part of a team working with the towns of Acton, Boxborough, Concord, Littleton, Maynard, Stow, and Westford, MA to launch CrossTown Connect, a regional mobility management program. The project transformed current disparate, uncoordinated, and

incomplete transportation services in the region into a new cooperative and coordinated system. The towns' Councils on Aging consolidated their previously separate shuttles and on-demand ride services under a single centralized dispatch call center, increasing each community's daily dispatch hours and ridership.
