

Transportation Capital Improvement Program Fulton County, GA



As Assistant Director and Director of Fulton County Public Works, Collaborative Sr. Vice President Angela Parker was responsible for the County's multi-modal transportation capital program, which at its peak totaled approximately \$400 million.

The program included road widening and intersection projects, advanced traffic management system improvements, and improvements to sidewalks multi-use paths, bridges and culverts. The scope of each project involved planning and concept development, public involvement, environmental approvals, design, right-of-way acquisition, cost estimating, budgeting, bidding and construction management. Projects executed using federal and state funds followed the Georgia Department of Transportation Plan Development Process; projects executed with local funds followed a fast-track process.
