

Program for Accessible Transportation Infrastructure Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority



The Collaborative is part of a team supporting the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority's Program for Accessible Transportation Infrastructure (PATI) project, a multi-year data collection and prioritization effort to improve accessibility. The team is assessing nearly 8,000 bus stops and more than 250 rail stations throughout the Boston metropolitan area. The Collaborative's ADA experts have guided development of the data collection phases, trained field assessors, and contributed to the quality assurance project, PATI is already informing the MBTA's capital improvements program and will have increasing influence on the types and extent of future accessibility improvements throughout the system.
